PUBLIC CONSULTATION ON AMENDMENTS TO ANIMAL MANAGEMENT LOCAL LAWS

On 20 September 2022, Torres Shire Council ("Council") resolved to propose amendments to Subordinate Local Law No. 2 (Animal Management) 2013.

The primary purposes of the amendments are to:

- provide that it is <u>prohibited</u> to:
 - o keep more than 2 dogs over the age of 12 weeks in any Multiple Dwelling Premises;
 - keep more than 2 dogs over the age of 12 weeks on an allotment with an area less than or equal to 600m²;
- Provide that Council approval is required to:
 - keep 1 or 2 dogs over the age of 12 weeks in any Multiple Dwelling Premises;
 - o keep 2 dogs over the age of 12 weeks on an allotment with an area less than or equal to 600m²;
 - keep 3 or more dogs over the age of 12 weeks on an allotment with an area greater than 600m².
- further define the minimum standards for keeping animals; and
- include more specific requirements around particular standards for keeping geese, ducks, chickens, roosters, turkeys and other poultry.

Public Consultation

From 22nd October 2022 – 27th October 2022, Council provided the community the opportunity to have feedback on the proposed amended subordinate local law at community consultations throughout the Shire .

Council now invites the public to provide written submissions on the proposed amendments. Submissions may be provided to Council in writing and may be delivered to Council:
