- (a) Reply to the **Department of Agriculture, Water and the Environment in** relation to the application under s. 10 of the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Heritage Protection Act.
- (b) Instruct Council's legal representatives to write to the legal representatives of the Applicant in the proceeding Kaurareg Native Title Aboriginal Corporation RNTBC & ORS v Torres Shire Council (QUD315/2019) to negotiate a settlement of the proceedings including

the question of costs and to do all things necessary to effect that settlement and discontinue the proceeding.

- (c) Instruct Council's legal representatives to write to the legal representatives of the Applicant in the proceedings *Kaurareg Native Title Aboriginal Corporation RNTBC and Milton Savage v Torres Shire Council* currently before the Planning and Environment Court (97/2019) to negotiate a settlement of the proceedings including the question of costs and to do all things necessary to effect that settlement and end the proceeding.
- (d) Instruct Council's legal representatives to defend any potential legal proceedings which may be brought by Pacific Marine Group in relation to Tender No 07/2018.

(2) to authorise the Chief Executive Officer to facilitate a meeting between Councillors and the Minister for Indigenous Australians concerning funding implications.
